Minutes - Approved via email and posted on website.

Treasurer's Reports – June 2021 Report was presented. Motion was submitted by L. Snapp and seconded by G. Modafferi to approve as presented – passed. Checking \$47,473.73; Money Market \$54,590.83; Street \$15,000.00.

Manager's Report – Submitted by L. Rogers.

Homeowners' Issues - Letter presented to Board. Issues addressed throughout agenda.

Pool Report

- 1. Pool Lighting A. Hernandez presented bids received. Discussion held. Motion was submitted by G. Modafferi and seconded by L. Snapp to approve \$3,700 to update and add lighting to pool area passed. A. Hernandez will schedule with vendor.
- 2. Music Volume Complaints Discussion held. Homeowners are encouraged to call 911 if the noise is not turned down after 10 PM. Pima County guidelines for decibel levels of 70 and under for 7 AM to 10 PM and under 62 for 10 PM TO 7 AM. Apps are available for phones to measure decibel levels.
- 3. Slippery Tile in Bathroom A. Hernandez will research options at janitorial supply shops.
- 4. Steps, Tile and Deck Repairs A. Hernandez reports we will be scheduled for the fall, after the pool closes. Pool water level needs to be lowered for this work.
- 5. BBQ (Clean Up Pail/Scoop) A. Hernandez is working on getting a free can for ash disposal.
- 6. Running Posted rules are not being obeyed. Homeowner suggests we hire a guard/monitor to enforce this rule. This was researched previously and found to be prohibitively expensive.
- 7. Children in Pool Without Parent Homeowners who see this should ask children to leave and return with parent.
- 8. Drug Deal Overheard by Homeowner 911 was called but they were gone when sheriff arrived. This is the proper procedure. All illegal activities should be handled by police.

New Business

- 1. Palm Tree Trimming Completed. All of debris was not cleared away. After discussion it was decided to get bids for a new vendor for the future.
- 2. Laird Fencing Homeowner notified Board of poor condition. The Board is aware of situation and has been discussing plans for improvement of the entire east lot.

Old Business

- 1. Pool Access System/Upgrade L. Rogers reports there are three options available from Comcast for WiFi, \$69 to \$89 a month (needed for new system). A. Hernandez asked L. Rogers to schedule install 3-4 weeks out. Motion submitted by R. Skeps and seconded by L. Snapp to approve \$120 monthly fee for new access system passed.
- 2. Drainage Channel Clean-Up A. Hernandez reports bids are coming in very slowly, therefore, we will table this.
- 3. Speed Bumps/Humps A. Hernandez will research cost of just one at this time.
- 4. Pathway North of Pool Completed.
- 5. Rock Landscape in Common Area A. Hernandez reports the cost to move river rocks and create new rock landscape is \$1,800. Motion was submitted by G. Modafferi and seconded by R. Skeps to approve \$1,800 to relocate donated rocks and landscape in needed areas passed. A. Hernandez to schedule.
