Minutes – G. Modafferi reported Minutes for May 31, 2023 were approved via email and posted on website June 9th.

Treasurer's Report – L. Snapp presented Report for June 2023. Motion was submitted by A. Leahy and seconded by S. O'Brien to approve as presented – passed.

Pool Report

- 1. Update on Complaints L. Rogers resolved an issue of non-residents at pool having a party. Another issue was also resolved when an impromptu party began at the pool with a resident. Reservation requirements were explained and issue was resolved.
- 2. Acoustic Sound Barrier/Wrought Iron Fencing Coverage L.Rogers reports it will arrive by freight. S. O'Brien will check with friend about installation.
- 3. East Gate Repairs Not closing properly. L. Rogers to schedule a service call.
- 4. Pool Rules and Procedures Went into effect June 15, 2023. Residents notified by USPS.
- 5. Palm Trees Complete trimmed before "bloom". Palms are now in full "bloom". L. Rogers to contact Comlete for additional trim.

New Business

- 1. Banking/Higher Interest for Savings Account L. Rogers reported current rate available is 4.1%. After discussion it was decided if there is an early withdrawal penalty fee of 5% or less, to go ahead and transfer funds to receive higher interest rate for HOA Savings. Motion was made by S. O'Brien and seconded by A. Leahy to approve transferring \$60,000. to a high interest savings account (currently 4.1%) with an early withdrawal penalty rate of 5% or less passed.
- 2. Options for Collecting Debt (first wall vendor) L. Rogers reported our attorney's explanation of how to proceed with recovery of our deposit,
- 3. Trash Collection Times G. Modafferi reports Hughes Sanitation has requested trash pick up early in the morning, due to the extreme heat we are experiencing.
